

Public Way of the Cross

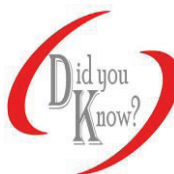
Fri. April 15 Gathering: 9 AM
