



Stewardship Moment- Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

In Saint Paul's letter to the Philippians he makes clear that Christ "emptied himself." He was not "full of himself." Jesus embraced the characteristics of

humility, service and obedience to carry out the will of his Father. Christian stewards know that there is no room for the Lord in a life that is full of oneself. Christian stewards follow Christ's example by taking on the characteristics of humility, servanthood and obedience. Our culture does not reward such attitudes. But God exalts those stewards who for His sake, empty themselves. It is only when we empty ourselves that there is room for God to work within us. 
St. Charles Pro-life Group-"<u>It's a Girl"</u>
