To mark these canonizations a number of celebrations are being planned in the Archdiocese: 1) <u>Sunday, April 27, 2014</u>, <u>at the 11:30 am Mass</u>, <u>at St.</u> <u>Mary's Cathedral</u>, presided by <u>Archbishop Richard</u> <u>Gagnon</u>, to honour both Popes on their day of canonization. 2) <u>Friday, May 9, 2014</u>, <u>at 7:30 pm</u>, at <u>Holy</u> <u>Ghost Parish</u>, <u>Winnipeg</u>, where there will be a Eucharistic celebration to honour the canonization of <u>Pope John Paul</u> <u>II</u>. 3) <u>Friday, May 30, 2014</u>, <u>at 7:30 pm</u>, at <u>Blessed (Saint)</u> <u>John XXIII Parish</u>, <u>Winnipeg</u>, where there will be a Eucharistic celebration to honour <u>Pope John XXIII</u>. -<u>Receptions will follow at all venues. All are welcome!</u>
