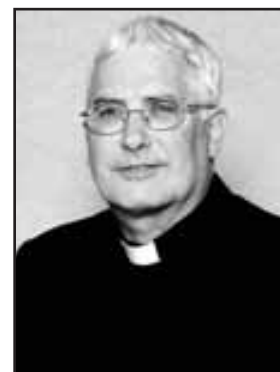

Recent words of Pope Francis: On a Mass on May 25, the Pope spoke about the importance of priests, parish workers and parishioners of being open and welcoming to those who come to the parish asking for something. He used the example of an unmarried mother asking for baptism for her child only to hear 'no, you aren't married.' The Pope, continued, *'this young woman had the courage to carry her baby to term and not have an abortion, and what does she find? A closed door! This is not good pastoral zeal. This pushes people away from the Lord. Jesus instituted seven sacraments, and we, with this kind of attitude have instituted an 'eighth' sacrament: the sacrament of pastoral control.'*

Also, at a Mass, on May 29, Pope Francis reminded the church that ... *'salvation comes from the 'cross of Christ', and that martyrdom is part of the life and journey of the church, and he asked that we pray for 'a humble church.'*
