

Accessibility Project Update

(Formerly Elevator Fund) Any major project in a church needs the approval of the Archdiocese and this has been requested. The project has been divided into two phases. The first is to replace the old stair-lift in the North entrance and the second is the construction of a ramp at the front of the church. We

have requested and received estimates for the replacement of the stair-lift and are now working on finalizing a contract. There are sufficient funds to cover the cost associated with phase one. Phase two has start in the we have asked our architects to develop proposals for the ramp so we can get a cost estimate. There will likely
