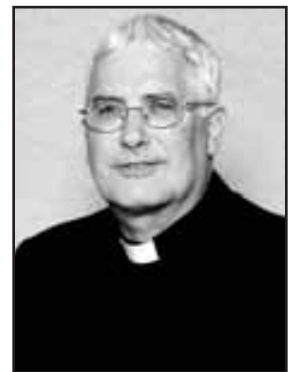

Stewardship Moment - Seventh Sunday In Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel Jesus continues to teach his followers how to embrace his attitude toward the Law, and its fulfillment. Among these familiar teachings, Jesus enjoins his followers to be generous givers without regard to whether they will receive equally back from those to whom they are being generous. He directs them not to refuse either the person who begs or the person who wants to borrow from them. They are not to react in these situations by trying to protect themselves and make sure that they will be treated fairly. Jesus wants his listeners to have an attitude toward another person that transcends that other person's character, motives or behavior. In this way, he maintains, they must be perfect, as their "heavenly Father is perfect." How might we cultivate such an attitude toward giving?
