



From Haiti- We continue to be busy with the children, and it is more enjoyable now that I remember their names. They are lucky to be here (at the orphanage), and when you think of their backgrounds I feel so much empathy and transmit all my love to each. One little girl had been abandoned, left in the church yard, and when found was near death; two older girls saw their father being assassinated because of a government issue, another boy was begging on the street.

Last week we had our first outing. We were invited to attend the official opening of a school and church in a remote area! Fr, Julmice (a priest that was in Limbe when I was there) is the administrator of the diocese of Cap Haitian while waiting for the appointment of a new bishop picked us up, In that area there are 2 groups of people that do not get along and kill each other, so there were security and national police to make sure nothing happened. We met a group of Americans who are sponsoring the project. Mardi Gras carnival is a big event here. We helped to make 60 hats for our children and staff here. We are expecting lots of dancing. The construction of the second floor of the school is coming along, It is being guided by a Haitian engineer, who has employed Haitian workers. Depending on the availability of funds coming from various donors the study rooms and library, and a dispensary is slowly progressing. From where I am sitting, I am admiring the landscape, the different shades of green of the mountains, the banana field, the huge mango trees. At the far end the 8 cows and calves, the goats are grazing.. on the other side the chickens, the turkey, and those roosters that wake us up exactly at 5 o'clock. This rooster each morning goes onto this tree, then the roof of a shelter near my bedroom and tells me morning has broken. Berthe also has one near her bedroom. The cats take care of the mice!!!!Lots of dragonflies to take care of the mosquitoes. Berthe and I are doing well. We heed the advice of missionaries to rest after lunch, as the heat is hard on our system. We have our meals with the Haitian sisters, have mass 2 times a week, and pray vespers with them. The sisters are very good to us, We are enjoying the coffee!!!!! plan to bring some home. Please share these news with the parishioners and my love to all. Louise Dansereau
