

As a follow-up to the Archdiocese of Winnipeg's first Synod which ended

Pentecost 2018, and in association with the Synod on Synodality recently called by Pope Francis, we are pleased to invite you to a **Zoom Listening Session to be held on Sunday February 27, 2022, at 1:00pm.**

During the session, a facilitator will present a series of questions that ask us to consider how God is calling us to better support and accompany one another in the faith journey.
