Dear parishioners,

We are still in a holding pattern as far as being able to reopen the church. Recently the province announced changes to the public health orders. Sadly, the churches were left out of the changes--apparently only 50% of Manitobans believe being able to attend church is important. It is apparent that there is concern that people gathering at church is too risky at this time. It is also apparent from looking at recent statistics provided through the freedom of information act that churches were least likely to spread COVID-19. However, test positivity rates at the time of the announcement this week are still over 6% in the Metro Winnipeg region, and there still are a fairly high number of people in hospital due to COVID-19, though it is going down slowly but surely. Even though the Winnipeg cases are averaging roughly 50+/-, things could easily go either way in the next 3 weeks pending how well people respect and follow the rules set out by Manitoba Public Health. The new current orders will last until Feb. 12th, 2021.

If things continue to go well in terms of total cases, test positivity and hospital admissions, there is a reasonable chance that more restrictions will be lifted in 2 weeks time. Hopefully churches will be given consideration at that time and we will be able to reopen just in time for Lent. I'm sure some of you are disappointed as I am and some of my brother priests are too, but we need to continue to be patient, remembering the government is trying to ensure this time that we will not have to go back on any changes. The changes that have been allowed are a good sign that we are moving in the right direction. These changes will especially help those who struggle to stay connected with others. These changes will help to allow more people to go back to work and give more normalcy in our lives.

Let's continue to pray for our government and those involved directly in the COVID-19 battle as they are trying their best and working overtime to help us all get back to some kind of normal life down the road. In the end, we are responsible for where we are at as a province in terms of COVID-19. Everyone of us is called upon to take responsibility for our actions and to remember that keeping the public health orders is loving our neighbor as Christ would have us do. Be assured of my continued prayers for all of us during these challenging times.
