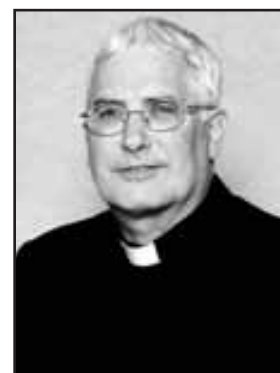

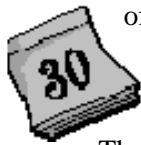
Thank you to all who set up for the Mass and Picnic last Sunday. It was a beautiful sunny day and thank you to everyone for making it a wonderful day!
