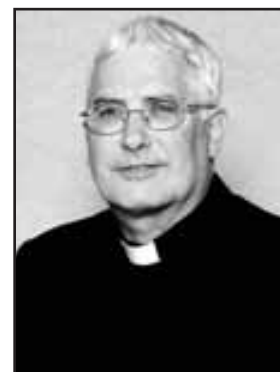

Pope Francis' reflection on 'unemployment' –

Recently, Pope Francis spoke about the unemployment situation affecting many people throughout the world, today. He said that it was often due to 'a purely economic conception of society which seeks 'profit' rather than seeks the parameters of 'justice'. He called for the solidarity of all persons and for politicians to encourage employment 'out of care for the dignity of the person', and he called for people everywhere to maintain hope. He called the young people to be committed to their daily duties of study, work, friendship, and to aid others, reminding them that their future depends on how they live these precious years of their lives. He said, "Do not be afraid of commitment, of sacrifice, and do not look with fear toward the future; keep your hope alive; there is always a light on the horizon." He concluded by reflecting that St Joseph and Mary both focused their attention on Christ, ... this, he said, is the model for us.

"Blessed Joseph" to be added to the Eucharistic Prayers II, III, & IV - On May 1, of this year, on the Feast of St. Joseph, the Worker, Pope Francis has promulgated the 'addition' of 'Saint Joseph, the spouse of Mary', in the Eucharistic Prayers II, III, & IV. Up, until now, 'St Joseph' was, only, officially, included in Eucharistic Prayer I, since the time of Pope John XXIII, in 1962. Pope Francis saw the need for the whole Church to seek continued intercession of such an august Saint as *Saint Joseph, the Patron Saint and 'Protector of the Universal Church' and the 'Protector of the Family'*.
