

Calendar of Saints Our Lady of Mount Carmel, July 16

The Carmelites have celebrated their patronal feast on this day since the 14th century. According to tradition, Saint Simon

on this day in 1251. The order of Carmel dates back to a group of Western hermits who in the 12th century settled on Mount Carmel, overlooking the plain of Galilee, in imitation of the prophet Elijah (see 1 Kings 18.19-46 and 2 Kings 2.25). They grouped themselves around a small chapel dedicated to Our Lady. In the 13th century, the Order of Carmel as we know it was formed, retaining the twin devotions of the early hermits: to Elijah and his

A Note about pastoral care during the summer months--Fr. Michael will be away for about 8 weeks (for studies and holidays) starting Thurs. June 29th. During this time, Ron Labbe and Richard Nichol, our trustees, will be in charge of all financial and temporal

matters for the parish. Deacon Robert and Deacon Claude are in charge of pastoral care (sacraments, funerals, etc.). If there is a death in the parish or need for a funeral, please contact the parish office, who in turn will get in touch with the deacons. If you are working with a funeral home for the funeral, please ask them to assist in finding a priest for the funeral if you are having a funeral Mass. If the funeral does not include a Mass, the deacons are able to do the funeral liturgy. Due to the length of Fr. Michael's absence, it was not possible to create a schedule for priests on call for emergencies or funerals. There is a priest on call for Grace Hospital every day and night of the week. At HSC, there is a chaplain during the day during the week and Tues through Fri evenings and overnight, there are priests on call for emergencies. Seven Oaks Hospital has priests on emergency on call every day and night of the week.

We will have a priest to say Mass for all the weekend Masses during the time Fr. Michael is away. If you know you are going to be in the hospital for surgery or other procedures, feel free to be proactive and ask them for the Sacrament of the Sick. There will not be any weekday Masses during this time. Also, adoration and Holy Hours will be cancelled for the summer months.

If you are looking for a baptism, contact the parish office. The priests who are coming to say Mass are able to do baptisms during the Mass, however, all baptisms must be cleared through the office as some baptisms have been booked for some weekends already.

A note from Fr. Michael--I want to thank everyone for their prayers and support. I will be headed to Detroit soon to begin Year 2 of the Licentiate in the New Evangelization. Hopefully it is not as hot as last year down there. I will be taking courses in World Religions and the New Evangelization, the Cultural Milieu of the New Evangelization, and the Spirituality of the New Evangelization. I am looking forward to the opportunity to grow in faith with over 40 colleagues from the U.S., India, Argentina, the Netherlands and perhaps some other nations. Please pray for me and all of us in studies and be assured that I will offer Mass for you as a community and continue to pray for you. Blessings to you all and have a great summer!
