Correspondence Re: St Charles Parish Helping the Syrian Christians Last Year-How the Funds Were Spent

May 18, 2016

Dear Fr Michael,

I send my warmest greetings to you and your parishioners.

First and foremost, we regret and sympathize with you regarding the devastating wildfire that engulfed the region of Alberta where many people lost their properties. It was very shocking. I implore our Mother Mary of consolation and restoration to intercede for the affected families and pray for fortitude for the whole nation at this time.

As I told you in the last email that I would send you the receipts of the expenditures available to me. I have enclosed them here. These are the receipts we were able to get when we did the shopping for them and paid hospital bills and bought medicines for them. Otherwise most of the time we give them money to do this themselves, to buy their respective needs, pay their house rentals and house utilities and also for their travel. It is difficult for them to get receipts for every item they buy and from their landlords who always refuse to give them because they spare some of their rooms for them to stay and collect some money for them at the end of each month. For us we don't mind much about this as long as they have a place to lay their heads owing to the difficulty of securing accommodations here.

We are remaining with only 3,130 liras (three thousand, one hundred and thirty liras) which will finish latest in mid June.

We would still need more of your assistance if it is possible.
