For weekday masses there is no need to pre-register beforehand, but you will be asked to at the door by the Ambassador. **For Saturday (4 pm) and Sunday (10 am) Masses, you will still need to register with the office (204-889-3248) by Fridays at 2 pm.**

PLEASE ARRIVE 15 MINUTES BEFORE THE START OF ANY MASS TO ALLOW TIME FOR CHECK IN AND EXPLANATION OF NEW PROTOCOLS FOR MASS.

Dear parishioners,

I hope you are enjoying the hot summer weather. It would be nice if it cooled down just a little--makes for better golfing and other outdoor activities. **I wanted to let you know that I will be away from July 1-14 inclusive. I will not be checking emails, so please hold off on sending them until my return if you can please.** I will be taking some holiday time and working on the thesis as well. During this time, for all pastoral inquiries Deacon Claude and Deacon Robert will be on deck. For normal office issues, please call or email the office. **Fr. Gerry Ward will be celebrating Mass with us for the weekends of July 4-5 and July 11-12. There will be no weekday Masses at this time. For the summer, Gloria will be in the office on Tuesdays and Thursdays; emails and phone messages will be monitored on the other days. If there is an emergency, call the parish office.**

As far as weekend Masses go, starting this weekend, **we will have Mass on Saturdays at 4PM and Sundays at 10AM**, with the Sunday Mass continuing to be livestreamed. **If you wish to attend either Mass on the weekend, you need to register through the parish office. Just a reminder that you must register by Friday 2PM in order to attend either weekend Mass. Starting in July, there will be no more restrictions for attending Mass--you can attend more than once a month.** Those from other parishes will be put on a waiting list so as to not take away spots from our community. We will have a limit of 50 for each Mass. There will be overflow allowed on Sunday mornings with the understanding that after the first 50, the next 50 will be seated downstairs and be able to see Mass via livestream and receive communion at the same time as the community upstairs. The maximum between upstairs and downstairs on Sundays will be 100--there are no exceptions to the limits at this time. Hopefully, as we get more help for parish ambassadors, people willing to help with livestreaming the Mass, and other ministries.

IF THERE IS NO AMBASSADORS FOR SATURDAY OR SUNDAY, WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO CELEBRATE THAT PARTICULAR MASS.

It was exciting to have a good size group last Sunday. Our protocols are working well and so we believe everyone can enjoy Mass again. Just a reminder that masks are recommended for Mass, especially since our numbers are growing and we want to keep everyone safe. Have a blessed summer and hope to see you in later July!
