



One AED is located at the main entrance to the Church by the stairway going up to St Patrick's Room and to the crying room. The second AED is located in the Parish Hall by the cloakroom. Thank you to the Father Allan Hall Council of the Knights of Columbus and to two parishioners of our Parish in purchasing these two AED's. These are used in emergencies when there is need to help resuscitate heart circulation.
