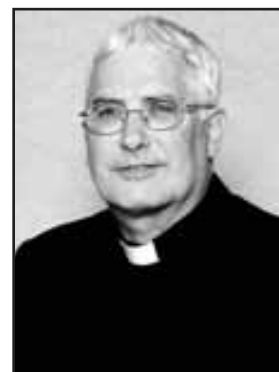

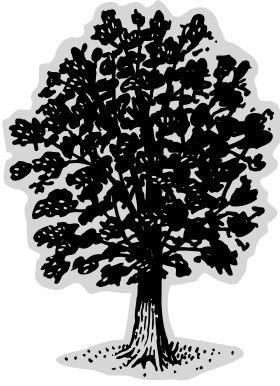

5) *Live in gratitude: to be a saint is to be fuelled by gratitude, nothing more and nothing less. Let no one deceive you with the notion that a passion for truth, for church or even for God can trump or bracket the non-negotiable imperative to be gracious always. Holiness is gratitude. Outside of gratitude we find ourselves doing many of the right things for the wrong reasons.*

6) *Bless more and curse less: we are mature when we define ourselves by what we are for rather than by what we are against and especially when, like Jesus, we are looking out at others and seeing them as blessed ("Blessed are you!") rather than as cursed ("Who do you think you are!"). The capacity to praise more than to criticize defines maturity.*

DID YOU KNOW? - Sharing God's Gifts

Recently you all received a letter from Fr. Paul, providing you with the Parish 2012 Financial Statement and some information on Sharing God's Gifts. The Finance Committee felt it important for all parishioners to understand what Sharing God's Gifts is about and decided to publish a monthly "DID YOU KNOW" item in the bulletin, today's being the first.

Sharing God's Gifts is about the greater Church beyond the boundaries of St. Charles. It is all our responsibility to support the Church as a whole

and not just the Parish needs.

Each year the Archdiocese sets a target for itself to meet the many needs of the Diocese. From there each Parish is given a target. This year our target is \$36,940 (a 2.8% increase over 2012). Our target is based on the previous year's offertory collections and the average number of parishioners over the past 3 years. Our target also considers our support for St. Charles Catholic School and would be higher if we did not support the school.

As outlined in Fr. Paul's letter there are many options for donating. Please give generously. Thank You.

Thanks to the generosity of the members of the St. James Assiniboia Catholic Women's League who attended the Pot Luck Dinner and Charities Auction, \$560 was donated to the Catholic School of Evangelization in St. Malo.
