





<u>Christian Maturity</u> - In this <u>Year of Faith</u>, let us grow more and more in 'Christian maturity'. Here are "two more reflections" (added on to the two reflections of last Sunday's bulletin), that can help us in that endeavor. (Two reflections will appear next Sunday and in the following Sundays' parish bulletins' announcements, until all 10 reflections are written for us to meditate upon). Please read them.

- 3) Let suffering 'soften' rather than harden our souls. Suffering and humiliation will find us all, in full measure, one way or another, and how we respond to them, with forgiveness or bitterness, will determine the level of our spiritual maturity. This is perhaps our ultimate moral test: Will my humiliation soften or harden my soul?
- 4) Forgive: in the end there is only one condition for entering heaven (and in living inside human community), namely, forgiveness. Perhaps the greatest struggle we have in the second half of our lives is to forgive: forgive those who have hurt us, forgive ourselves for our own shortcomings, and forgive God for seemingly hanging us out unfairly to dry in the world. The greatest moral imperative of all is not to die with a bitter, unforgiving heart.


