



Jesus said "A man had two sons, and the younger said to his father, "Father give me the share of your estate that should come to me." So the father divided the property between them. After a few days, the younger son collected all his belongings and set off to a distant country where he squandered his inheritance on a life of dissipation. (Lk 15:11-13)

This week's parable is about loss-a lost son. It is also about someone who takes the initiative to find what is lost-the father runs down the road to embrace and kiss his lost son. The father represents God. When things are tough, I often wonder, "What do I do at a time like this?" What I do is I let God find me. What I do is open myself up to God who is taking the initiative right now to reach out to me. Without God I am lost, in the dark. And when I find God-or rather, when I let God find me, and I listen to what God has to say and resolve to do what God tells me to do. When I am the lost son (or daughter), I can take heart. The Lord is reaching out to me, especially when I feel very, very lost.

Today, this Fourth Sunday of Lent, is called Laetare Sunday which is also known as 'Rose Sunday' or 'Refreshment Sunday', which has a counterpart on the Third Sunday of Advent or Gaudete Sunday, when the 'purplecoloured vestments' of the Mass, as worn by the priests during Lent and Advent, are exchanged for 'rose-coloured vestments'. The point of both days is to provide 'encouragement' to all of us as we progress and journey toward the end of each respective penitential season. Laetare Sunday is viewed as a day of celebration and joy, on which the austerity of Lent is briefly lessened. The passage from Isaiah sums it up: "Rejoice with joy, you that have been in sorrow." This year, at St Charles Parish, we are blessed with a 'new' 'rose-coloured' vestment fit for this Laetare Sunday. As far as we know, or at least, as far as we are aware of, St Charles Parish has not had a rose-coloured vestment. Today, it has, and it will be the first time that it will be worn at Mass. On a side note, parishioners should be made aware that it was, in fact, paid for by a donation from a parishioner of St Charles Parish who wanted to offer something 'special' to the Parish. We thank that parishioner for this kind offer. Therefore, today, - Let us rejoice and be glad in God's love and mercy for us! Amen!

# <u>Development and Peace-Share Lent 2013 Human Dignity-More than Ever</u>

Human dignity is the right to fair working conditions. Mining is one of the most dangerous forms of labour in the world. Ante Oyos de Serra Caja Martino, who worked as a miner in Peru, knows this all too well. He began to work in a foreignowned mine at the age of 23, but was forced to guit at the age of 31 after developing a physical disability. disability was caused by the way heavy equipment is handled in the mine and because there is no care provided to workers," he said. He added that most of the miners were also suffering symptoms of mercury contamination. The company that owns the mine did not recognize that the illnesses and injuries suffered by the miners were the result of their working conditions. Adverse health effects are part of the many social impacts created by mining activities on D & P partner THE EPISCOPAL local communities. COMMISSION FOR SOCIAL ACTION (CEAS), is providing training to local community leaders to help them understand their rights in the face of mining companies and other extractive industries in their communities, and is supporting them in defending those rights. For Ante, who participated in training workshops offered by CEAS, he is grateful for having a second lease on life in defending the rights of his community so that others will hopefully not suffer a similar fate. Your generosity last year helped CEAS do their work. Will you continue to provide that help? Next Sunday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, is Solidarity Sunday. A collection will be taken up for Development & Peace - you may use the envelope provided in your box of envelopes or you may pick one up at the back of the church. Please make your cheque out to St. Charles Parish, marked for D & P. The donation will be forwarded and the amount included on your tax receipt from the parish. Your commitment to human dignity is needed more than ever in our world today.


