



Stewardship Moment-Third Sunday of Lent

In today's first reading from the Book of Exodus, we hear of the hardships endured by the people of Israel on their wilderness journey out of Egypt. The

wilderness is a demanding place for human life. Just trying to survive can seriously test our faith. In the Israelites' journey away from a life of slavery and oppression, harsh conditions challenged their trust in the God who liberated them. But their transition brings them closer to God, and they are constantly reminded of the Lord's gracious provision and nurturing. Good stewards believe the Lord's presence transforms their own "wilderness" experiences into a place of divine mercy and nourishment. Reflect on your own "wilderness" experiences.
