



Poor Simon was walking in from the fields and, without even knowing why, he suddenly gets a crossbeam across his back. He walks in the footsteps of Jesus.

It's the way discipleship often is. I may not know why I have been given this cross (just as Simon didn't know why).

All I can do is carry my cross and walk in the footsteps of Jesus. And trust.

Holy Week and Easter is upon us and it is truly a time of deep and profound religious significance for all Christian believers. Let us make this time a time of grace and blessings by attending the Holy Week Services given to us by the Church. There is the Holy Thursday Mass at 7:30pm with the washing of the feet reminding us of the love and service of one another as taught by Jesus, followed by the recalling of the Last Supper of Christ in the Holy Eucharist, and followed by the Procession and the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight reminding us of Jesus' prayer in the garden of Olives. Good Friday Service at 3:00pm, with the Reading of the Passion of Christ, followed by the Intercessions for the whole world and the Veneration of the Cross and Holy Communion. The Good Friday Collection is for the support of the Holy Land. The Easter Vigil is at 9:00pm, in the darkness of the Church, recalling the 'eve' of the coming of the First Day of the Resurrection of Christ which comes at daybreak. The Paschal Candle is lit from the fire, and our individual candles are lit, too, in the darkness of the night. The Exultant is 'sung' to the praises of God, and the Readings are read and the Psalms are sung, reminding us of God's love and promises throughout the generations. The 'Glory to God' is sung to the lighting up of the 'lights' and the Vigil continues with the Baptisms and the Reception of "the neophites" (the newly Baptized and those to be 'received' in the Church). The 'Litany of Saints' is sung at the Vigil, in our needs, in communion with all the Angels and Saints of Heaven. Our own profession of faith (with individual candles lit), is proclaimed and we enter into the Holy reception of the Eucharist. Alleluia is exclaimed throughout. Alleluia! Alleluia! Indeed. Easter Sunday Masses are at 9:30am & 11:30am on March 31, on the last day of month of March. Let us rejoice and celebrate! May God bless you all! - Fr Paul Tinguely


