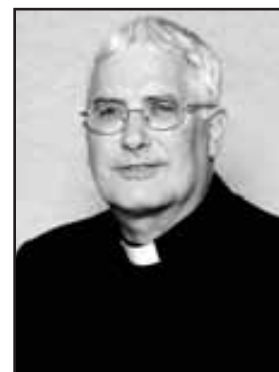

### *Stewardship Moment- Fourth Sunday of Lent*

In today's second reading Saint Paul urges us to try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. The Bible often emphasizes our need to please God at all times and Saint Paul would find it inconceivable that any follower of Christ would lack a desire to please the Lord. But how do we discern what pleases the Lord? It has been said that one of the quickest ways to get a glimpse into what pleases God is to read the Bible. Reading the Bible reinforces what we have heard preached and taught about God's will. The practice also transforms our understanding of God's desires for us. If you now read the Bible, how has it helped you understand what pleases God? If you don't read the Bible, why is that?
