



In today's second reading Saint Paul urges us to try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. The Bible often emphasizes our need to please God at all times and

It has been said that one of the quickest ways to get a glimpse into what pleases God is to read the Bible. Reading the Bible reinforces what we have heard preached and taught about God's will. The practice also transforms our understanding of God's desires for us. If you now read the Bible, how has it helped you understand what pleases God? If you don't read the Bible, why is that?
