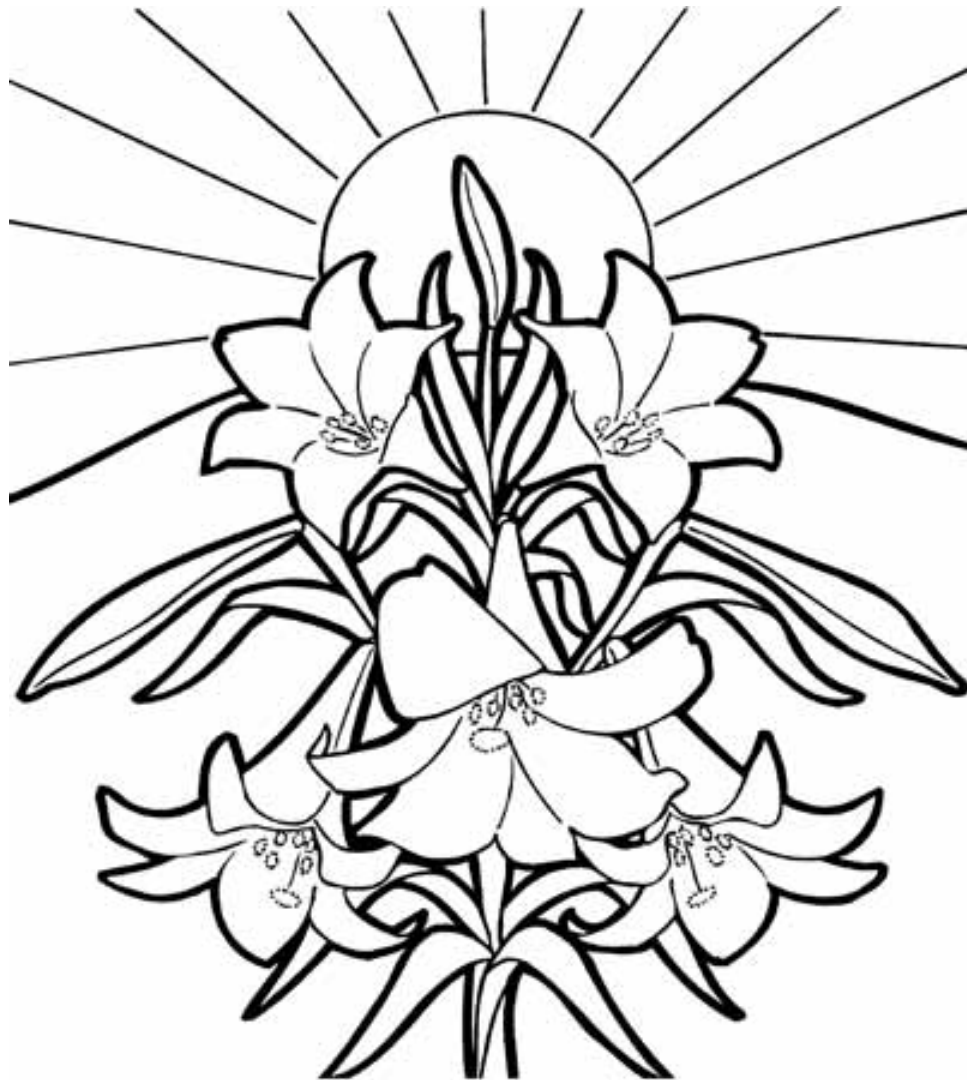

“The two men said to the woman, “Why do you seek the living one among the dead? He is not here, but he has been raised. Remember what he said to you while he was in Galilee, that the son of Son of Man must be handed over to sinners and be crucified, and rise on the third day.” (Lk 24:5-7)

Sometimes it’s when I’m alone in deep thought or deep prayer.

Sometimes it’s in other people who are so good that I can just sense the presence of the Lord in them.

It happens to me in many different ways, and it *should*.

But I probably don’t always acknowledge those experiences as part of what it means to be a believer.

I should thank the Lord for such experiences because they can be the bedrock of my faith.
