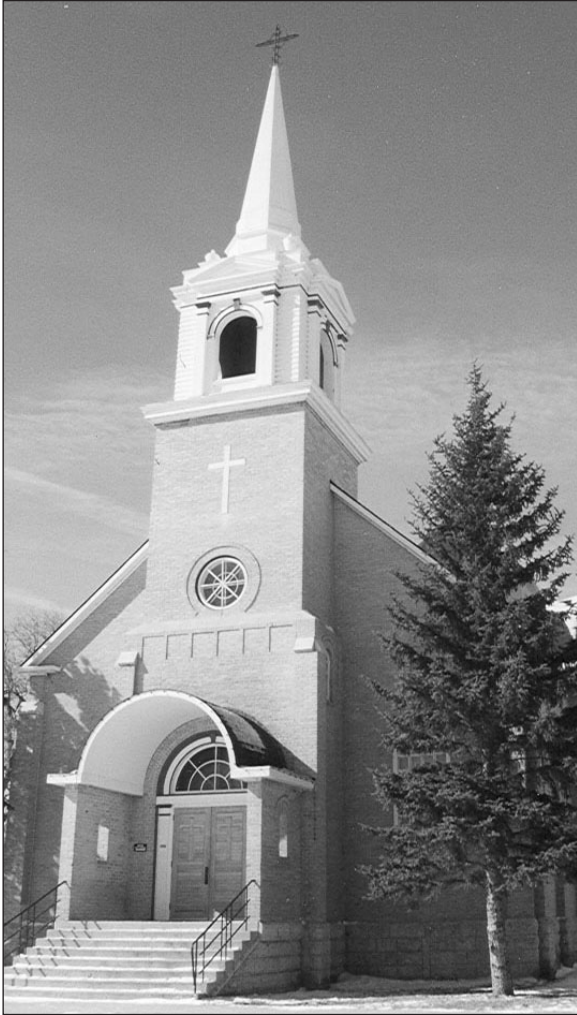

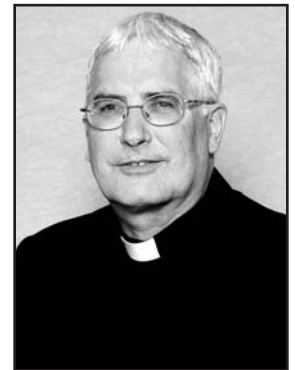

"Doubly poor are those

women who endure situations of exclusion, mistreatment, and violence, since they are frequently less able to defend their rights. Even so, we constantly witness among them impressive examples of daily heroism in defending and protecting their vulnerable families." - Pope Francis, "The Joy of the Gospel" (#212).

Supporting women and girls is a priority for D & P. When 276 girls were kidnapped by Boko Haram from Chibok in Nigeria, our local Nigerian partner began working for their freedom, and had managed to smuggle three girls to safety. *"The girls, who were 17, 18 and 19 years old, still seemed to be under the effect of the swirl of emotions generated by the trials they experienced since their abduction,"* states Raphael Yimga Tatchi, D & P program officer for Nigeria, *"... their voices and eyes betray deep pain ... but glimmers of humanity shine through when they courageously recount the details of their escape."* The Share Lent collection for D & P is on the Fifth Sunday of Lent, March 22nd.
