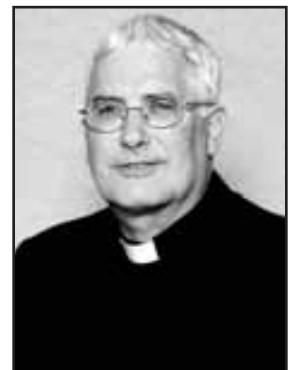

### *Stewardship Moment- Fourth Sunday of Easter*

In today's first reading Peter tells his listeners that if they want to follow Jesus they must go against the world, to become what Christian stewards would consider "countercultural." For stewards, being countercultural can consist of surprisingly small decisions—small acts of reorientation to remind them daily that in spite of their life situation, their citizenship, financial status, or color of their skin, they belong, through their baptism, to a new world order in Jesus Christ. Stewards understand that their daily choices should witness to his gospel, not to the trends, attitudes or spending practices of their culture. Stewardship requires us to ask of our daily habits and decisions: "In the light of Christ's Gospel, is this important?" **The National Week for Life and the Family, May 11-18, 2014**, held throughout Canada, is an opportunity to speak about things that trouble the human heart, namely, the reality of death and suffering. With the advocacy for euthanasia and assisted suicide in Canada, we need to remember that for thousands of years, the 'Hippocratic Oath' marked an important watershed in medicine, to preserve life and not to do harm. But, new voices, today, pose a test for our civilization and for modern medicine. Saint John Paul II spoke often of a "civilization of love", the essence of which, is the inviolable dignity of human life in all of its stages. Euthanasia and assisted suicide pose a threat for our Canadian culture and civilization in that these ideas are framed as an argument for human progress and medical aid. This gives the impression of concern for freedom and human dignity. However, in reality, these arguments deeply trouble us. The National Week for Life and the Family provides us with an opportunity to discuss and reflect on these important matters. Let us pray that hearts will be changed so that all life will be valued and honoured.
