Foundation work – old part of the Church

Foundation work will be done on the north-side wall of the “old” part of the Church. Because of this there will be need to temporarily close the stairway (closest to the main entrance) from going to the basement. We are, therefore, asking parishioners to be attentive to this, and to use the other two side stairways during the repairs. Thank you

Parish mortgage – Because of the impending repairs on the church foundation wall which could cost up to \$10,000, and due to the fact that cash flows are always a concern for the parish with the added fact that there will be no “Garage Sale” this spring in the Parish, the time schedule for “paying off” the debt has been “extended” to the end of 2012 or until the beginning of the first months of 2013. The Parish has asked the Archdiocese to reduce the repayment amount for the mortgage to \$2,500 a month from last year’s amount of \$4,000 a month. The Archdiocese has accepted and it has taken effect since January 1, 2012. This step has curtailed, for now, cash flow problems that the Parish experiences at various times of the year. With this in mind, the Parish is thankful and appreciative to you, the parishioners of St Charles Parish, who continue to support generously, through your Sunday offerings, the means for our parish to meet its financial obligations. The Parish is also very thankful and appreciative to the various parish organizations, like the Ladies Association, and the Knights of Columbus, that have, also, helped financially, the Parish in the past. As an important side note, the Parish financial report of 2011 is in the final stages of being completed and will be mailed within weeks to parishioners.

This trip is planned by an organization called Mountain Child. This organization was established in Nepal because 1 in 5 children there will die before the age of 5. Most Nepali parents will not even bother naming their child before the age of 5, as chances are it will die, due to malnutrition and poor medical conditions. Mountain Child offers medical aid, food, supplies, support and love to the families and children of the villages in the Himalayas.
