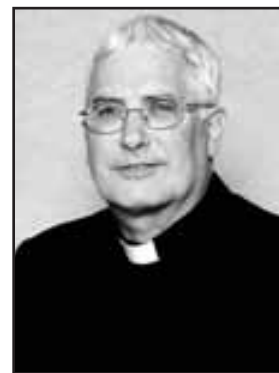

Parish mortgage – Because of the impending repairs on the church foundation wall which could cost up to \$10,000, and due to the fact that cash flows are always a concern for the parish with the added fact that there will be no "Garage Sale" this spring in the Parish, the time schedule for "paying off" the debt has been "extended" to the end of 2012 or until the beginning of the first months of 2013. The Parish has asked the Archdiocese to reduce the repayment amount for the mortgage to \$2,500 a month from last year's amount of \$4,000 a month. The Archdiocese has accepted and it has taken effect since January 1, 2012. This step has curtailed, for now, cash flow problems that the Parish experiences at various times of the year. With this in mind, the Parish is thankful and appreciative to you, the parishioners of St Charles Parish, who continue to support generously, through your Sunday offerings, the means for our parish to meet its financial obligations. The Parish is also very thankful and appreciative to the various parish organizations, like the Ladies Association, and the Knights of Columbus, that have, also, helped financially, the Parish in the past.
