



#### Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

I wanted to follow up on something that we need to do as a community of faith. Given the current situation with the bill on physician assisted death before the House of Commons, we need to continue to pray. I invite you to join me in a day of fasting and prayer on Tuesday May 31st. We will have the church open from 7AM on. There will be Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament from 7AM-7PM. We will have sign-up sheets at the back of the church for this weekend and next weekend. There will be halfhour slots available. We are looking for at least two people for every half hour so that the Lord Jesus will not be left alone. For those who can't make it to the church we would be grateful for whatever fasting and prayer can be achieved. For those who cannot fast from food, any fast will be an acceptable gift to the Lord to bestow grace on our Members of Parliament and all involved in the legislative process. We will pray that God's will be done in this situation. It is always important to remember that we should not be concerned if nothing happens immediately--God's grace will be fruitful where and when it is supposed to be. Even if it does not change things today, there's nothing saying that it may not change tomorrow. I thank you for making this sacrifice out of love for God and for all Canadians. We pray as well for those who are struggling with end of life issues whether it be physicians, nurses, anyone in the health care field, for those who are suffering in tremendous pain, especially those who may not have access to the care they need at this time. May God's Love direct our government and bring hope and healing to those in need.

# Correspondence Re: St Charles Parish Helping the Syrian Christians Last Year-How the Funds Were Used Dear Fr. Michael, (May 4, 2016)

I wish you and your parishioners the Joy of the feast of the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

I am writing to once again to thank you and your parishioners for your support and to give you a report on the assistance to the Syrian Christian migrants through your donation. Your donation has been a big relief to them as it has been very difficult for them to cope with life situation here. They are all grateful to your benevolence. I would like to inform you that your assistance goes beyond assisting them but also the Christians from Iraq.

After the Holy Father advised that we adopt at least a family in every parish, we have adopted one Syrian Christian family of five, the father and four daughters. Unfortunately the wife was arrested in Syrian when they could not arrest her husband. Unfortunately the family does not have contact with her and does not know if she is still alive or dead, it is a pathetic situation for the children especially. They tried to cross over to Europe through the sea but were turned back to Turkey. We're always praying for them for fortitude. Two of the girls are studying Turkish language and music to enable them get job despite the difficulty of getting job here.

I would like also to inform you that there are other poor people who are very much in need. They are like the Canaanite woman in Matthew 15: 22-28 who came to Jesus and told Him to help her drive away evil spirit from her daughter, and Jesus told her He was sent only for the lost sheep of Israel. And the woman told Jesus that "Even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from the master's table". And at the end Jesus granted her request and her daughter was cured judging from her desperation and faith. In view of this we are asking your permission if we can also help these people in a little way from your donation. Below are the expenses made so far and the balance.
