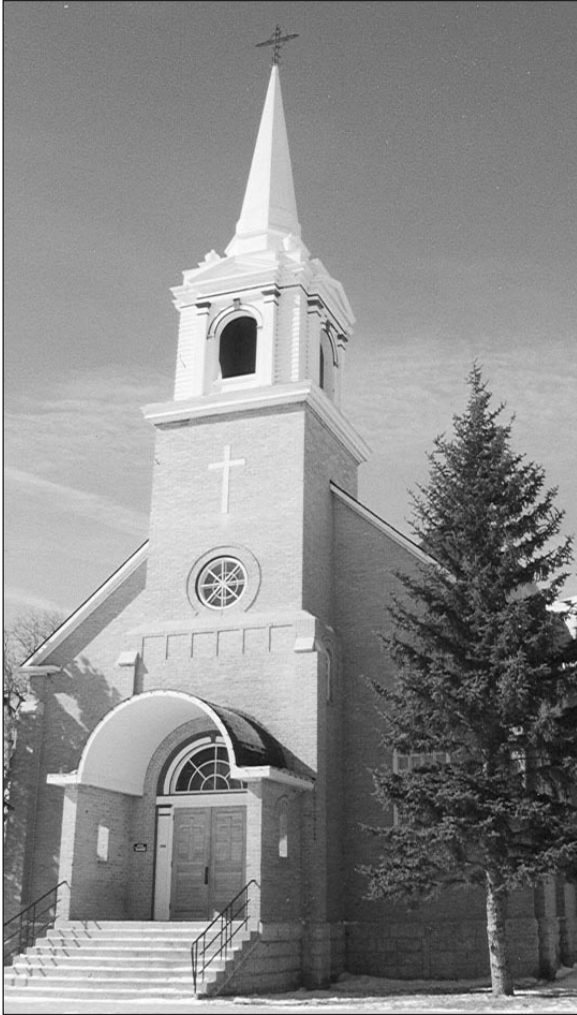

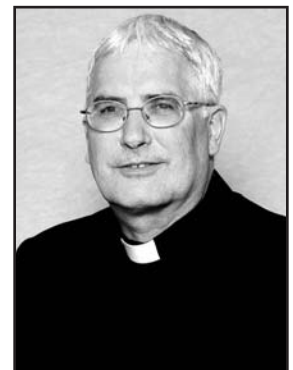

The First National Shrine of Saint Gianna Beretta

Molla: On **Sun., May 10 at 7 p.m.**, the first Canadian Shrine in honour of St. Gianna Beretta Molla will be blessed and inaugurated by Archbishop Richard Gagnon, Archbishop of Winnipeg, in St. Gianna Beretta Molla Roman Catholic Church. The event, celebrated in the context of evening prayer, will include the unveiling of a bronze statue of St. Gianna by artist John Collier. St Gianna's daughter, Gianna Emanuela, will be in attendance.

The **Archdiocese of Winnipeg Jubilee/Centennial Mass** is today, Sunday, May 3, at 1:00pm at the MTS Centre. There is expected to be close to 14,000 people attending with 825 candidates to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. All of St Charles Parish's tickets have been given away, 270 tickets in all, not counting the Confirmation candidates and their sponsors and parishioners who will be in the choir and those helping in other various functions. There will be up to 10 Bishops attending the Mass including the Papal Nuncio to Canada who is representing Pope Francis. There will be a banner representing St Charles Parish at the entrance to the Centre along with the banners of all the other parishes and missions represented in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg. A Jubilee Icon of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph will also be unveiled. 26 candidates from St Charles Parish will be Confirmed. We pray for them and their families in this special occasion and for continued growth in their faith. Again, as a reminder there will be no 11:30am Mass today on May 3rd.

L'Arche Winnipeg Walkathon Kevin Hanson, son of Muriel Hanson, is celebrating his 50th birthday on May 10th. In his honor, the family is raising money for L'Arche Winnipeg, which has been home to Kevin for much of his life. L'Arche was founded in 1964 by Canadian humanitarian and social visionary, Jean Vanier. Distressed by the institutionalization and the isolation and loneliness of people with intellectual disabilities, Jean Vanier invited two men from an institution to live with him in a small house. He called the house "L'Arche," a French word for "the ark" in the biblical story of Noah and the flood. L'Arche Winnipeg was founded in 1973 and Kevin has lived there since 1979. The L'Arche Winnipeg Walkathon takes place May 3rd and the Hanson and (Sean & Lisa) O'Hara families, along with many cousins, nieces and nephews, will be walking as Team Hurry Up Hanson.
