

Opening of Synod Process On Pentecost **Sunday, May 15,** 2016, we will open our Synod Process in the Archdiocese of Winnipeg. Solemn Evening Prayer will be celebrated at Mary's Cathedral beginning at 7:30 pm. This evening will mark the beginning of our two year Synod Process.

<u>Pastor's Notes</u> Dear parishioners,

We have received good news that the petition against physician assisted suicide that our Archbishop asked us to sign back in the fall has had an impact. Robert Falcon-Ouellette, a Manitoba MP, has brought our petition and concern forward on behalf of our Archdiocese and Manitobans. He too is very concerned that this bill will send a negative message and will not help the aboriginal community, especially the youth. He has openly said he will vote against the government on the bill currently before the House of Commons. In turn, Archbishop Gagnon has asked us to pray even more as the deadline of June 6th approaches. As a parish, we will seek to do a special time of prayer for this specific concern. More will be announced in the near future.

Congratulations to those who are making their First Communion today! We are proud of you as a parish and hope that you will be reminded more deeply that God wants to be a part of your life. Today you enter more deeply into the life of Christ as you receive Him in His Body and Blood. May you continue to grow in your relationship with Him and become more like Him in your words and deeds and your life. May you be joyful witnesses that He is with us!

While I'm on the subject, I want to address some questions that have arisen about communion and the practice of receiving communion at Mass. The correct teaching of the Church is that communion may be received in the hand or on the tongue. Both are legal and acceptable. In Canada (and United States) there is an indult from Rome which allows us to receive in the hand. The archbishop has confirmed that this is the correct teaching here in Canada. Therefore, it is personal matter of faith as to which way one chooses to receive communion. There is a holiness and spirituality to both ways. All should be respected regardless of which way they choose to receive communion. It is also important to note though, that the normal custom for receiving communion at Mass in Canada is to stand. However, the practice of receiving communion kneeling is also allowed. We should be grateful that someone is coming forward to receive communion and that they are witnessing to the faith in that act. Both ways are equally holy and not to be judged. At Mass, we are here to worship God together and pray and support each other in faith as the Body of Christ; we are not here to focus on how our neighbour is praying. Our focus should always be to look for the Presence of Jesus Christ in our midst at the celebration of the Mass. We are a parish that continues to follow the direction and guidance of Archbishop Gagnon and I am grateful that we are in communion with him and our Archdiocese. We continue to be open to the gift of Vatican II in our parish, as is the Archdiocese.

The Archbishop is pleased that we are seeking to do the parish visitation and hoping for good fruit from it just as we are. I am happy to say that visits are underway and I am grateful to the team, made up of members of the Pastoral Council. Thank you to all who have answered God's call to serve as visitors to the parishioners and also to all of you for your prayers for our parish and its growth. May God bless you always and may we journey together with Him who has called us in love to be a community of faith and to serve.
