

COVID-19 UPDATE

As we can currently see, the situation in our city is still not improving. However, it may take longer to see results in terms of new cases and test positivity rates to go down. I encourage everyone to continue to be patient, faithful to carrying out the essentials in our church such as wearing a mask, sanitizing and social distancing, and handwashing where needed. In any case, the PPC and I are monitoring the situation and will be in conversation during this time. If necessary, we will lower the limits for those allowed to come to the weekend Masses in order to ensure a lower exposure rate. However, at the same time, there are no known transmissions of the COVID-19 virus in the Winnipeg metro churches that we are aware of and so we will hold the current course of a maximum 30% capacity. We ask that everyone register for the weekend Masses from this point on because if we have to change limits, we may no longer be able to allow walk-ins.
