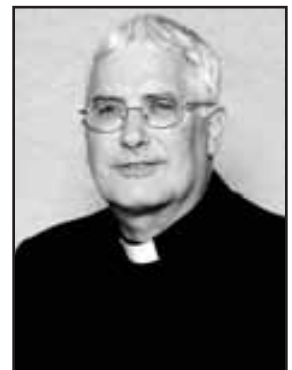

**Development & PEACE – FALL ACTION 2013** Are you Listening? Do you remember signing cards seven years ago to petition our government calling for stronger accountability standards for Canadian mining companies operating in the Global South? Half a million Canadians supported Development & Peace’s campaign requesting the creation of an independent OMBUDSMAN with the power to act on complaints from our partners in the global south. Instead, the government established the Office of the Extractive Sector Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Counsellor as a way to address complaints from affected communities. This voluntary, non-judicial grievance mechanism has shown to be ineffective and remedial solutions have not been forthcoming. “ARE YOU LISTENING?” is a call to action AGAIN with our partners in the Global South. We are being asked to be their VOICE FOR JUSTICE! Bishop Bolen, president of the Justice and Peace Commission, has said, “When the wealth of our country is built on the backs of others, our wealth is our shame”. Also, Pope Francis has reminded us that we are called to emulate God’s special love for the poor. This is our opportunity to join all Canadians in being a voice for justice. **In next week’s Parish bulletin there will be an insert prepared for us by Development & Peace giving us more concrete information on the situation at hand. Please read it. Then, on the weekend of November 23/24, we will be asked to sign a petition card,** calling forth, again, that an independent OMBUDSMAN be set up for stronger accountability of Canadian mining companies operating in the Global South.
