Urgent Note about Parish Finances

We would like to draw your attention to the fact the parish still has over **\$23,000.00** to collect for the **Archdiocesan Support** (Sharing Gods Gifts and Assessment) to meet our obligation. These programs support the good works of the Archdiocese and every parish in the Archdiocese is asked to contribute. We all benefit from the works of the Archdiocese. Please give generously.

Any short fall in our obligation will have be covered by drawing for our emergency reserve as there is currently insufficient funds in our general account to cover this obligation. In fact, if the Harvest Dinner had not been so successful, we would have drawn from the emergency fund to pay the annual insurance of \$11,620.00 that just came in. The parish has run a deficit in all but two months this year.

We have just over \$43,500.00 in our emergency fund. Drawing down this fund would leave the parish very venerable financially.
