

CHANGE" In 1967 Canada's Bishops created the organization THE CANADIAN CATHOLIC ORGANIZATION FOR DEVELOPMENT AND PEACE'. One of its mandates was to collect funds to help the global poor through 'Share Lent'. The second mandate was a request that we educate ourselves. In December world leaders will gather in Paris for the UN Climate Change Conference (COP21), to negotiate a new international agreement that will determine the future of the world's climate. Pope Francis, through his encyclical "Laudato Si", has chosen this crucial year to call on every living person to act on climate change and protect our common home. In our world it is the poor who are paying the biggest price. D & P has joined an international alliance of 17 catholic development organizations from Europe and North America called "Change for the Planet - Care for the People". World leaders are urged to commit to ambitious climate action and solve this urgent crisis – Canada included. We need to support our partners in the Global South, but we also need to reduce our own greenhouse gas emissions in order to reduce the dramatic impacts of climate change. This is our fall campaign - climate change education to help "create a climate of change". Be a part of this movement to protect the Earth!
