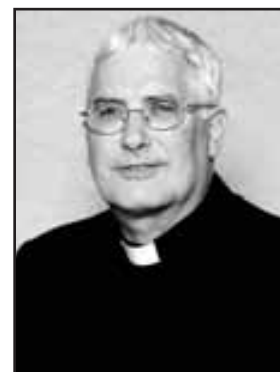

Remembrance Day

Today is the Feast Day of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica - Most Catholics think that St. Peter's Basilica is the Pope's main Cathedral Church in Rome, but they are wrong. The St. John Lateran Basilica is the Pope's Cathedral Church in Rome. It is the Cathedral Church of the Archdiocese of Rome where the Archbishop of Rome, who is the Pope, presides. The first basilica where St John Lateran Basilica presently sits was built in the fourth century (and was consecrated in the year 324) when Emperor Constantine donated it to the Church. That structure and its successors suffered fire, earthquakes and ravages of war, but the Lateran has remained the church of the Pope, and by virtue of this, it is the 'parish' church of the whole Church of God. The present structure was built in 1646, and sits by the "Lateran Gate", hence, the name: "The Lateran Basilica", and is dedicated to 'St John the Baptist'. Today, we are reminded of the importance of taking special care of our own sacred bodies which like all sacred churches are dedicated to God.
