Sacrament of the Sick next Saturday Oct.24th and Sunday Oct. 25th

Extra opportunities for prayer--new evening Mass and Holy Hours with Confessions

We will be adding an extra evening Mass on Wed. evenings at 7PM (when possible) to give another option for people to experience God's love for them.

Prayers before weekend Masses-- 30 minutes before each Mass we will have either the Rosary or the Chaplet of Divine Mercy in order to create more of an environment of prayer here at St. Charles. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

This fall we will be starting a new program at St. Charles Parish for children, age 3-6, called the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. It will meet each Monday from 4:00 to 6:00 beginning in late October. The program will take place in a special room called the "atrium." In the ancient church the atrium was the room outside the basilica where people were prepared for baptism. At St. Charles, the atrium will be prepared with beautiful materials that the children will have the chance to take down and work with. We will use the St. Patrick's room next to the children's cry room. It will still be available for parish meetings. More details are available on a sheet at the back of the church. Meanwhile, we are looking for materials for our atrium: small trays (plastic or wood), baskets, small glass pitchers and bowls, large scraps of cloth of the liturgical colours (purple, green, red and white), candle snuffer, clipboards, child-sized tables & chairs.
