

Dear parishioners,

Some questions have come to my attention since we have instituted mandatory mask wearing at St. Charles Church. This is reminder to everyone that masks are mandatory to be worn in the parish, especially at the Mass and/or other gatherings or business in church, even in the pastoral office. This will remain in effect until further notice, even after the Code Orange restrictions are **lifted**. This is a conscious decision to protect the health of every member of our community to the best of our ability. By wearing the masks for the sake of everyone's health we are living our Christian faith. We are also helping to put people at ease who otherwise may not come to church if they feel it is not a safe environment to be in. We need to set aside our individual preferences here for the good of our Christian community and wear our masks at church. Unless one is totally alone in the church praying or doing work, the expectation is that we will wear a mask out of respect for each other. There are obvious exceptions for those doing ministry for the Mass (lectors, musicians, cantors, presiders) as it is hard to carry out certain liturgical functions while wearing a mask. We will wear masks before, during and after the celebration of Mass when we are in the church--the only normal exception is in the actual moment of receiving communion and consuming the host. The only exception for the mask wearing rule is by way of a medical exemption (an official note from the doctor will be required) stating that one cannot wear a mask. Other objections will not be accepted as a valid reason for not wearing a mask at our church. If you do not have a mask or forget one, do not worry, we will provide you with one. The mask wearing will extend to even asking children to wear masks as well (where possible).

As a parish, we have to keep the government orders as a bare minimum. Being a good Christian also means being a good citizen and respecting lawful government orders. Under the Code Orange health order for Metropolitan Winnipeg, those found not to be wearing a mask in indoor public spaces could receive warnings and/or fines from the government. Businesses and/or organizations such as churches that do not keep the minimum government orders could also be fined and/or closed. It is also important to note that as a parish we have and do reserve the right

to go above the minimum government restrictions if we deem that it is necessary for the health and well-being of our community. We will exercise that right as needed.

Thanks to everyone for their support, patience and sacrifices in these matters. I realize that this is not easy for everyone to carry out, but we will be blessed in the long run for doing what is right.

Announcement from the Archdiocese

The Provincial Government has updated COVID-19 restrictions on public gatherings for the Winnipeg Metropolitan Health Region. Parishes in the North Winnipeg, Central Winnipeg, and South Winnipeg deaneries, as well as Notre Dame Church (Selkirk), Christ the King Church (Stonewall), St. Joseph's Church (Stony Mountain), St-François Xavier Church (St-François Xavier), St. Theresa's Church (West St. Paul), and St. Margaret's Church (Little Britain), are affected by these new restrictions.

Effective Monday, September 28, 2020, there will be a restriction on indoor and outdoor gatherings to ten (10) people. While these new restrictions do not apply to 'Faith Gatherings' including Mass, they will apply to the celebration of weddings, funerals and baptisms. The current restrictions on gatherings for Mass, including social distancing, remain. The use of face masks is also required for all indoor public gatherings.
