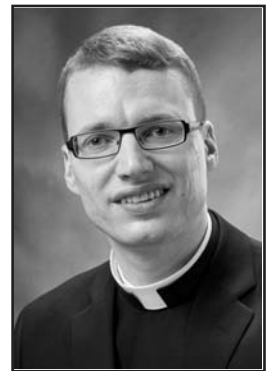

Sacrament of the Sick this Saturday Oct.24th and Sunday Oct. 25th

Following the Masses on the weekend of Oct.24-25 we will be giving an opportunity for those who need the sacrament of the sick and/or prayers for healing.
