



### Sacrament of the Sick this Saturday Oct.24th and Sunday Oct. 25th

Following the Masses on the weekend of Oct.24-25 we will be giving an opportunity for those who need the

sacrament of the sick and/or prayers for healing. This sacrament is for physical, mental, emotional and spiritual healing, and includes the forgiveness of sin. The roots of this sacrament go back to the letter of James in the New Testament. People are welcome to come forward to receive this sacrament who are of the age of reason (age 7 or Grade 2) and older. Particularly seniors, those dealing with chronic health issues, getting ready for surgery, those who have suffered or are suffering greatly emotionally, mentally or spiritually are welcome to receive the sacrament. If you are not sure whether or not it is for you, you may ask Fr. Peter or Fr. Michael and they will indicate to you whether or not to receive the sacrament or prayers for healing. Let us pray in a special way this coming week in preparation for those who need this healing ministry. Members of the community are welcome to remain and pray in silence for those seeking the Lord Jesus Christ in this sacrament.
