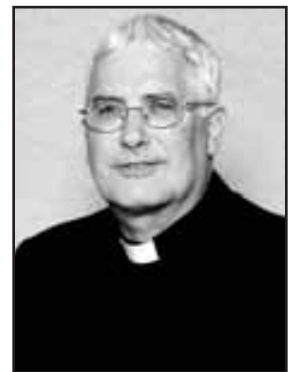

Reminder, Daylight Savings Time Ends:
 Remember to turn your clocks back an hour before you retire for the night next Sat Nov 2nd as the time change takes effect the next day, Sunday November 3rd. There are Catechism Classes Sunday.

Confirmation Preparation Classes for Grade 8 students & Catechism Classes for Grade 7 students – It is now the time for **all** students who are in Grade 8 to prepare now for receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation which will take place in the spring of 2014. Classes have already started. **All students in Grade 8 (all those going to 'Catholic Schools' and all those going to 'non-Catholic Schools') 'must take' the Sunday morning 10:30am catechism classes with Father Paul Tinguely in preparation for their Confirmation. Grade 7 students 'who do not go' to Catholic schools must also take the 10:30am catechism classes on Sundays, with Father Paul Tinguely in preparation for their Confirmation in two years.** Students in Grade 7 **'who do go' to Catholic schools** would not need to attend catechism classes with Father Paul Tinguely at this time, because they are already receiving catechetical instruction at school, but they would need to attend in the following year. To register your son or daughter for Confirmation preparation and catechism classes, please contact **Laurette Noakes** or **Father Paul Tinguely**. Please note that the **Catechism/Confirmation classes for Grade 7 & 8** are held in **St Patrick's Room** which is located upstairs from the entrance foyer of the church.
