

News from Chemin Neuf: For those of you new to the parish, Chemin Neuf Community runs the St. Charles Retreat Centre across the street. Ted and Nancy Wood, who have been managing the retreat centre for the last 9 years will be leaving in December to work with Chemin Neuf in London, England at a parish called Christ the King Parish, Cockfosters. A new couple, Antonio and Christiane Cardoso have come to take over the running of the centre and leading the community in Winnipeg. Coming from Quebec, they have been in quarantine for two weeks, but will emerge in time for Mass on Sept. 20. They are looking forward to getting to know the parish! Kevin and Anne-Lise Bhaga, who have been here for three years, have decided to return to Mauritius, their home country. They will continue to be involved with Chemin Neuf there. They plan to leave in November after the birth of their third child.

Dear parishioners,

I want to update you on a few items with regards to our weekend celebrations. Firstly, we have succeeded in getting back the Sunday 1130 AM Mass, so we are at a full weekend schedule now. I want to reassure everyone that there is enough time to clean the area after the first Mass. However, as we are celebrating the Sacraments of First Communion and Confirmation in the parish at the Sunday 1130AM Mass for the next several weekends, it is really important that everyone who plans on attending the 1130AM Mass registers for it, so that we can prepare properly in the parish. We prefer that people register for all the Masses, though those who just show up will be allowed in provided there is space (1130 has been filling up).

# MASKS AT CHURCH

Our numbers at the weekend Masses are increasing. The last two weekends we have seen roughly 150 people for the Masses combined. After consultation with the PPC and in light of the



rising community transmission of the COVID-19 virus in our city, we have decided that masks will now be mandatory for those attending church and are to be worn for the entire celebration (with exceptions for those who are reading when they read at Mass, those playing or singing at Mass and those presiding). The masks may be taken off to receive communion when it is your turn to receive, but we ask that everyone keeps the mask on when in line to receive communion and returning to your pew. This will be effective immediately.

### LIVESTREAMING AT MASS



For the next few weeks Sept. 27th, Oct. 4 and Oct. 11, we will be livestreaming the Sunday 1130 AM Mass for the sake of those guests

and family members who cannot attend the ritual Masses for celebrating First Communion and Confirmation. After Oct. 11, most likely we will be returning to livestreaming the Sunday 930AM Mass. We have just received the new equipment and hopefully soon we will be switching over to YouTube live for our streaming of the Masses. Just a note though that we will have forms available at the back of the church to give permission for your children to be on the livestream as it is necessary to get a release by law if they are going to appear on the web (as is the case with the sacraments).

## Announcement from the Archdiocese

The Provincial Government has updated COVID-19 restrictions on public gatherings for the Winnipeg Metropolitan Health Region. Parishes in the North Winnipeg, Central Winnipeg, and South Winnipeg deaneries, as well as Notre Dame Church (Selkirk), Christ the King Church (Stonewall), St. Joseph's Church (Stony Mountain), St-François Xavier Church (St-François Xavier), St. Theresa's Church (West St. Paul), and St. Margaret's Church (Little Britain), are affected by these new restrictions.

Effective **Monday, September 28, 2020**, there will be a restriction on indoor and outdoor gatherings to ten (10) people. <u>While these new restrictions do not apply</u> to 'Faith Gatherings' including Mass, they will apply to the celebration of weddings, funerals and baptisms. The current restrictions on gatherings for Mass, including social distancing, remain.
