



A WORD (OR TWO!) FROM FR. MICHAEL:

Holy Father's request for October: You probably have heard by now that Pope Francis is looking for special prayers from all Catholics for the Church throughout October, as this month is traditionally dedicated to Mary. The Holy Father urges all Catholics to pray the rosary daily for the month of October and include a prayer to St. Michael the Archangel to repel the attacks of Satan against the Church. With all of the controversy and scandals of the Church at the present, this is important for all of us to do--I certainly am and invite you to do the same. The rosary is very powerful in defeating evil, evil spirits and Satan himself. It is a tool at our disposal and we should take advantage of it. It is also important to realize that in praying the rosary, we do not worship Mary, but rather ask for her to pray with us and for us, to intercede for us and take us to her son Jesus.

While we are on the subject of Mary, the Rosary will be celebrated every Wednesday evening in October at 630PM here in our church. We will have a couple of nights on Marian spirituality for the month of October in our parish. The first will be Thursday Oct. 18th at 715PM in the Church; the second will be Wednesday Oct. 24th at 7PM after the rosary. We are also interested in giving thanks for the gift of Marian devotions and spirituality in our lives. If anyone is interested in giving a little testimony at Mass or writing one for the bulletin, please let me know.

<u>Elevator Project</u>: We are still pursuing an elevator for St. Charles. We will take money out of our Elevator Trust Account, which is at about \$60,000, to fund the drawings of the elevator project. We then can get a fairly accurate sense of the cost of the elevator project. At present, we are in contact several architects, discerning which one to go with for the drawings. Once we have the drawings, we will present them to the parish, hopefully before year's end. By having an estimate of the actual cost we can secure community grants and hopefully corporate funding as well. The parishioners will also be asked for financial support. Whatever is not met by these sources we would loan from the Archdiocese. The timeline for the project will depend on the financial support we receive. We are confident that the project is still viable, needed and reasonable. If the project is deemed not viable, then we will pursue other options such as the chairlift, a outdoor ramp, etc. Thanks for your patience and understanding and please continue to pray for the Finance Council. More to come on this project in the near future.
