

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is the process through which interested adults and mature teenagers are introduced to the Roman Catholic faith and way of life. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

This fall we will be starting a new program at St. Charles Parish for children, age 3-6, called the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. It will meet each Monday from 4:00 to 6:00 beginning in late October. The program will take place in a special room called the "atrium." In the ancient church the atrium was the room outside the basilica where people were prepared for baptism. At St. Charles, the atrium will be prepared with beautiful materials that the children will have the chance to take down and work with. We will use the St. Patrick's room next to the children's cry room. It will still be available for parish meetings. More details will be available soon. Meanwhile, we are looking for materials for our atrium: small trays (plastic or wood), baskets, small glass pitchers and bowls, large scraps of cloth of the liturgical colours (purple, green, red and white), small brush & dustpan, candle snuffer, clipboards, child-sized tables & chairs.
