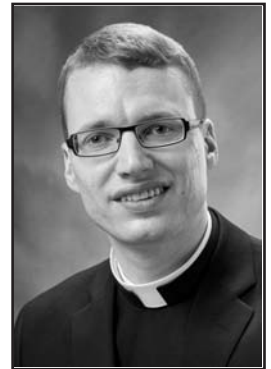

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

This fall we will be starting a new program at St. Charles Parish for children, age 3-6, called the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd.
