

EXPLANATION OF NEW PROTOCOLS FOR MASS.

Dear parishioners,

I hope everyone has had a good summer...with the arrival of September brings about changes and announcements for the parish:

Adoration and Holy Hours: will not start until October, as we have a shortage of ambassadors. Hopefully starting the first week of October we will be able to restore this devotion to the community.

Weekend Masses: Starting the weekend of September 12-13, we will be going back to our regular schedule of Mass on Saturdays at 4PM, Sundays at 930 and 1130. We still need people to register for which Mass they intend on attending. This will be particularly important as for the next several weeks, hopefully starting on Sun. Sept. 13th at 1130 AM, we will be celebrating First Communions and/or Confirmations for our catechism students who have patiently been waiting. Those who are parents of First Communion and Confirmation students will be receiving an email shortly about the plans and their options to celebrate those sacraments with the community.

Weekday Masses: The regular Mass schedule will be Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays at 9AM. Please note that the Wed. morning Mass will be at Chemin Neuf in conjunction with faith sharing which will take place after the Mass. However, due to the limited space in the Chemin Neuf chapel, it will be necessary to register for Mass if you plan on attending there--we will not be able to take people who just show up for that Mass due to space limitations, in order to keep a safe environment.

Catechism: The proposed plan (which has yet to be confirmed by PPC), is to have catechism between the Masses on Sunday mornings in the Church Hall and other areas (church, outside, possibly Chemin Neuf), as we are unable to use the school for catechism this fall as in the past, due to COVID-19 concerns in order to protect both the

St. Charles School community as well as the parish community from potential outbreaks. Registration will begin on the weekend of Sept 12-13 in the church hall below. More details to come. Just a note that we are looking for a Grade 6 catechist, a catechist to take over the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd program (as Deacon Ted and Nancy Wood will be leaving to take on a new posting for Chemin Neuf in Britain). There will not be a confirmation class this year, as we are taking this year to set up a new program for 2021-2022. We are looking for 2 catechists who may be interested in helping teach confirmation, who we will work with this year to train and create the new program.

Ambassadors: We are grateful to all who have assisted with the ministry of ambassador over the last while--we could not open safely without you! Having said that, we will need extra help in order to keep the Sunday 1130 Mass and the other Masses going so our crew does not tire out. The ambassadors are taking an extra shift in September in order for us to be able to restart the Sunday 1130 AM Mass. Please consider helping out in this important ministry. If interested, contact the parish office.
