#### DEAR BROTHERS AND SISTERS,

The side of Jesus Christ is the source of new graces especially for unbelievers and people who are in the state of sin! Look at the Picture of Jesus Divine Mercy - you will see the white and red rays which radiate from the open side of Jesus. You remember that the soldier, after the Crucifixion of Jesus, pierced by his lance and immediately blood and water ran from open side. We are blessed - dear Brothers and Sisters - because we can not only contemplate this beautiful picture of Jesus, the Divine Mercy, but we pray for Jesus' mercy for us and for the whole world repeating for the sake of his sorrowful passion have mercy on us and on the whole world! The story connected with the picture of Jesus Divine Mercy was, first of all, the initiative of Jesus himself. Jesus asked St. Sister Faustyna Kowalska to paint this image and He promised that all who venerate this picture never perish and He defend them forever! At the beginning Sister Faustyna thought that Jesus asked about the picture in the soul but Jesus repeated, I want a real picture painted with paints, and S. Faustyna directed the hand of the artist, Eugene. After the first efforts of the artist, S. Faustyna began to cry - Jesus, who will paint you as beautiful as you are? Jesus answered to her, the beauty of this picture is in my grace! Jesus is in a white robe which symbolizes joy and resurrection. The right hand is the gesture of a blessing and the left reveals the white robe and we see the shining rays, white and red – whoever will take the rays of my mercy will receive Divine Mercy. The eyes of Jesus are similar to the eyes of Jesus crucified at Golgotha, embracing all sinners of the world.



I give you the vessel of Divine Mercy – venerate my mercy and I will give you my forgiveness!

Does the modern world really need the presence of God and his Mercy? We would say, as never before should the world be immersed in Divine Mercy. Why? We have in the world many conflicts. The war in Syria, Ukraine, dramatic tension in the Middle East, the persecution of Christians... The newspapers mention the use of nuclear weapons. This kind of nuclear war is in the minds of only one group of people infected by evil but everyone would pay the consequences of nuclear war!

We need to enkindle Divine Mercy and have hope. We need to pass on the flames of

mercy – in God's mercy, the world will find peace and the people will find happiness. This task must be completed by you, dear Brothers and Sisters. Be witnesses of mercy, of Divine Mercy. Let us open the door to Jesus' mercy! Fr. Piotr Machnacki SAC

# **B**FIRST COMMUNION



# FORGOTTEN FACTS ABOUT FATIMA

Modifications to the Five First Saturday Devotion to facilitate its practice. The original request of Our Lady asks one to confess and receive Communion on five consecutive first Saturdays; to say five decades of the Rosary; to meditate during 15 minutes on the mysteries of the Rosary for the purpose of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in reparation for the sins of men. In subsequent private visions and apparitions however, Sister Lucia presented to Our Lord the difficulties that devotees encountered in fulfilling some conditions. With loving condescension and solicitude, Our Lord deigned to relax the rules to make this devotion easy to observe:

 Confession may be done on other days other than the First Saturday so long as one receives Our Lord worthily and has the intention of making reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
 Even if one forgets to make the intention, it may be done on the next confession, taking advantage of the first occasion to go to confession.

3. Sister Lucia also clarified that it is not necessary to meditate on ALL mysteries of the Rosary on each First Saturday. One or several suffice.

With much latitude granted by Our Lord Himself, there is no reason for the faithful to hesitate or delay this pious practice in the spirit of reparation, which the Immaculate Heart of Mary urgently asks.

**Your actions** in church show respect for God and for the community that gathers there. If you are stopping by the church to pray, even just for a moment, your actions should respect the place and its purpose.

Spit out your gum, turn off your cell phone before you step into a sacred space and time.
