At the end of 2016, the parish's finances were substantially improved. This was primarily the result of reduced staff hours/salaries and the commitment of volunteers to undertake custodial duties. The Parish has paid off all its outstanding debts to the Chancery (\$89,000). These funds were cleared at the beginning of 2017. The loan balance had been reduced somewhat through funds raised from Parish events. We also had to settle <u>an outstanding installment of \$26,125 owed to the</u> <u>Canada Revenue Agency. This amount was billed for payroll</u> <u>benefits owed to our former employees. That portion was paid in</u> <u>01 2017.</u>

The Cathedraticum for 2015 [reduced by 50% by the Chancery] was included in our total payment of debts. The

Cathedraticum for 2016 will come due this year. At this time, we have not yet received the total amount owing.

We all are very grateful for your financial support and permanent generosity!
