#### <u>ADVENT</u>

In todays Gospel, the Church brings John the Baptist, the man who prepared the people for Christ's public mission, before our minds today, as an example that we should follow, even if only from afar. John prepared himself for the test of welcoming and introducing Christ to others, by a life of self-mortification and penance. He told the

people that the first essential for getting Christ, and profiting by his coming, was that they should turn away from sin and give up any evil ways. He himself practiced what he preached and his preaching, therefore, bore fruit among many of his hearers. John is calling on us too today, to prepare ourselves for Christ's coming this Christmas, by turning away from sin, and by the mortification of ourselves in many ways.

Today we light the third candle (pink), which symbolizes joy. It is called the "Shepard's Candle," and is pink because rose is a liturgical color for joy. The third Sunday of Advent is Gaudete Sunday and is meant to remind us of the joy that the



world experienced at the birth of Jesus, as well as the joy that the faithful have reached the midpoint of Advent.

#### **BIG HEART FOOD COLLECTION**


