#### 276. What is forbidden by the ninth commandment?

The ninth commandment forbids all thoughts and desires contrary to chastity.

#### 277. What is the tenth commandment of God?

#### 278. What does the tenth commandment forbid?

## WHAT DOES THE NAME OF **Setus** MEAN?

Memorial Day - January 3



The name Jesus comes from the Greek Iesous which was derived from the Aramaic, Yeshu. It means "Yaweh is salvation." The name was not unique, even in biblical times, and today it is common in Arabic-speaking East and in Spanish-speaking countries. From apostolic times the name has been treated with the greatest respect, as honor is due the name which represents Our Lord, Himself. The Holy Name of Jesus is, first of all, an all-powerful prayer. Our Lord Himself solemnly promises that whatever we ask the Father in His Name we shall receive. God never fails to keep His word. When, therefore, we say, "Jesus," let us ask God for all we need with absolute confidence of being heard. For this reason, the Church ends her prayer with the words, "through Jesus Christ," which gives the prayer a new and Divine efficacy.



**Basil the Great** (died in 379 A.D.) and **Gregory Nazianzen** (died in 390 A.D.) are linked in this feast day, as they were in life; they were schoolmates, codefenders of the orthodox teaching on the Trinity, and dear friends. Both served as bishops and suffered hostility from the politically powerful Arians. As a bishop, Basil the Great fed the poor, addressed the destitute and the marginalized, and created a hospital

for the sick. Gregory Nazianzen, a lover of solitude and philosophical contemplation, delivered majestic oration on the Trinity that earned him the title "The Theologian." Both men developed and solidified the Trinitarian formulations of the Church in the face of Arian heresy.
