MARY IMMACULATE

This Wednesday the 8th of December is the main feast day for the Oblates of Mary Immaculate. Fr Paul will go to his community in Mississauga for a day of retreat. In the evening we will have the Rosary at 6pm in English and Polish followed by a bilingual Mass at 6:30pm in honour of our Lady.

For the past several decades, the Pope has blessed the Baby Jesus figurines from Nativity Scenes that belong to families, and the families themselves, in St. Peter's Square in Rome. The blessing takes place on Gaudete Sunday,

After the blessing you are encouraged to take your 'Bambinelli' home and place it in a gift box, wrap the box and save it for Christmas. Let this be the first gift you open on Christmas day!


